# The Real von Trapp Family: FACT FROM FICTION

- Maria was a teacher in the monastery's school in Nonnberg when the abbess sent her to help in the von Trapp house.
- Maria came to the von Trapp family in 1926 as a tutor for one of the children, also called Maria, who was recovering from scarlet fever, not as governess to all the children.
- Maria and Captain Georg von Trapp married in 1927, 11 years before the family left Austria, not during the Nazi takeover of Austria.
- Maria did not marry Georg because she was in love with him. As she said in her autobiography, she fell in love with the children at first sight, not their father. She is quoted as saying, "I really and truly was not in love. I liked him but didn't love him. However, I loved the children, so in a way I really married the children... By and by I learned to love him more than I have ever loved before or after."
- The number of children and their names, ages, sexes were changed for the show. The family was also musically inclined before Maria arrived, but she did teach them to sing madrigals.
- Georg, far from being the detached, cold-blooded patriarch of the family who disapproved of music, was a warm and loving if somewhat overwhelmed father. Author Tom Santopietro writes, "It was actually Maria herself, with her emotionally stunted upbringing,



who needed thawing," as Maria had grown up in an abusive home. While this change in Georg's character might have made for a better story in emphasizing Maria's healing effect on the von Trapps, it distressed his family greatly.

- Instead of the fictional Max Detweiler, pushy music promoter, the von Trapps' priest, the Reverend Franz Wasner, acted as their musical director for over 20 years.
- The family did not secretly escape over the Alps to freedom in Switzerland.
   As daughter Maria said in 2003, "We did tell people that we were going to America to sing. And we did not climb over mountains with all our heavy suitcases and instruments. We left by train, pretending nothing."
- The von Trapps travelled to Italy, not Switzerland, in broad daylight under the guise of a family vacation, the day before the borders to Austria were closed. They then travelled to America to tour as a family band and eventually settled there.

SYNOPSIS - In Salzburg, Austria before the Second World War, the misfit postulant Maria is assigned to the home of the hardened widower Captain von Trapp as governess to his seven rebellious children. The children are musically inclined, much to the interest of Max Detweiler, a close family friend and musical organizer for the Kaltzberg Festival. As the connection between Maria and the Captain begins to grow, Maria suddenly flees to the abbey, driving the Captain to propose to the stunning Elsa Schraeder. After conversing with the Mother Abbess and confronting her romantic feelings, Maria returns to the family where she and the Captain are married. While on their honeymoon the Anschluss arrives and Captain von Trapp, against his will is ordered to return to naval service for the Nazis. With the family set to perform in the festival, they devise a plan to escape their beloved country.







Richard Rodgers

Music

Richard Rodgers (1902-1979) was an American composer who worked primarily in musical theatre. With 43 Broadway musicals and over 900 songs to his credit, he was one of the most well-known American composers of the 20th century, and his compositions had a significant influence on popular music. He is known for his songwriting partnerships with lyricist Lorenz Hart and Oscar Hammerstein II. With Hart, he wrote musicals throughout the 1920s and 1930s, including Pal Joey, A Connecticut Yankee, On Your Toes and Babes in Arms. With Hammerstein. he wrote musicals through the 1940s and 1950s, such as Oklahoma!, Flower Drum Song, Carousel, South Pacific, The King and I and The Sound of Music. His collaborations with Hammerstein are celebrated for bringing Broadway musicals to a new maturity by telling stories that were focused on characters and drama rather than the earlier light-hearted entertainment of the genre.



Oscar Hammerstein II
Lyrics

Oscar Hammerstein II (1895-1960) was an American lyricist, librettist, theatrical producer, and (usually uncredited) director in musical theatre for nearly 40 years. He won eight Tony Awards and two Academy Awards for Best Original Song. Many of his songs are standard repertoire for vocalists and jazz musicians. He co-wrote 850 songs. He is best known for his collaborations with composer Richard Rodgers, as the duo Rodgers and Hammerstein, whose musicals include Oklahoma!, Carousel, South Pacific, The King and I and The Sound of Music. Described by Stephen Sondheim as an "experimental playwright", Hammerstein helped bring American musicals to a new maturity by focusing on stories and characters rather than the light-hearted entertainment that the musicals had been known for beforehand. He also collaborated with Jerome Kern (with whom he wrote Show Boat). Vincent Youmans, Rudolf Friml, Richard A. Whiting and Sigmund Romberg.

## Howard Lindsay and Russel Crouse Book

Howard Lindsay (1889–1968) was an actor, stage manager, director and playwright before teaming up with Russel Crouse. Russel Crouse (1893–1966) was a newspaperman, a press agent for the Theatre Guild, the author of several books and a librettist before partnering with Howard Lindsay. Lindsay and Crouse's partnership stands today as the longest collaboration of any writers in theatrical history, lasting for more than 28 years. The two men first joined forces in 1934, when the producer

Vinton Freedley brought them together to rewrite the libretto for Anything Goes, which Lindsay directed. Two years later, they wrote another Cole Porter show, Red, Hot and Blue. Their first straight play, Life with Father, opened in 1936 and holds the record for the longest-running play on Broadway, at 3,224 performances. Among other shows, Lindsay and Crouse also wrote The Sound of Music (score by Rodgers and Hammerstein); the Pulitzer Prize-winning State of the Union; Call me Madam and Mr. President (scores by Irving Berlin); The Prescott Proposals and The Great Sebastians. They produced The Hasty Heart, Detective Story and Arsenic and Old Lace.




