#### CHARACTER DESCRIPTIONS AND REQUIREMENTS:

#### (Please Note: The roles of Howard Beale, Max Schumacher, Louise Schumacher, Edward Ruddy and Harry Hunter have been cast)

**Diana Christensen**: Female, 30s, any ethnicity. Head of Programming at UBS. Self-absorbed. Driven. Brutally honest.

**Frank Hackett:** Male, 30s, any ethnicity. Executive Senior Vice President of UBS. Very ambitious. He's sharp and aggressive, with a real swagger about him.

**Arthur Jensen**: Male, 60s, any ethnicity. He owns the network. He has natural power, like a strict father figure.

**Nelson Chaney**: Male, 50s, any ethnicity. President of UBS. An old-school TV executive. Flustered and incompetent—runs the network, but in name only.

Jack Snowden/Warm-Up Guy: Male, 30s, any ethnicity. A new, fresh face. Capable of being serious as a newsreader and funny as the warm-up guy.

Schlesinger: Female, 20s-30s, any ethnicity. Polite and efficient, earnest and eager to impress.

**Sheila**: Female, 20s-30s, any ethnicity. A production assistant. A sure pair of hands, used to the pressure of running the show.

**Director**: Male, 40s-50s, any ethnicity. A little worn out by years on the show, so perhaps a little rough around the edges, but still very skilled at his job.

**NOTE:** There will be 3 extras in each city (who do not travel with the production). The extras will perform as non-speaking CAMERA OPERATORS and other small non-speaking roles. If you are interested in being considered for an Extra in addition to a speaking role, please note that in your audition submission. If you are <u>only</u> interested in being considered for an Extra, please write NETWORK EXTRA in the subject line.
