WINNIPEG, January 21, 2025 - Told through music, song, and dance, *Indecent* brings a powerful and evocative story to the Mainstage. From Pulitzer-Prize winning playwright Paula Vogel comes a stunning play about one of the most shocking events in theatre history. *Indecent* tells the true story of the rise and explosive demise of Sholem Asch's *God of Vengeance*. Celebrated across Europe and in New York's Yiddish theatre, when the play makes its English language transfer to Broadway in 1923, it proves too scandalous, and the entire company are arrested on the grounds of obscenity.

Royal MTC's Artistic Director Kelly Thornton directs: *"Indecent* is more pertinent now than when it made its Broadway debut in 2017. It deals with themes of antisemitism, homophobia, anti-immigration and censorship, and speaks to me not only as a love letter to the theatre, but to the power of art in a fractured society."
