WINNIPEG, March 5, 2025 - Royal Manitoba Theatre Centre brings Casey & Diana, one of the most talked-about new Canadian plays, to prairie audiences this spring. Originally produced by the Stratford Festival in 2023, it showcased the power of community, compassion, and the human spirit in the face of the AIDs crisis. This co-production with Theatre Aquarius features Winnipeg's Cathrine Wreford, who takes on the iconic role of Princess Diana in a cast of six that delivers a story filled with courage, humour and perseverance.

In addition to sharing this powerful story, Royal MTC is fostering community connections with Nine Circles Community Health Centre. This organization provides low barrier, culturally safe prevention services, comprehensive care, treatment, advocacy and education for Manitobans susceptible to, or living with HIV and works to eliminate the stigma and advocates for health equities. Since Casey & Diana is a true story from Toronto, Canada, this connection provides audiences a chance to learn more about Manitoba's history with the HIV/AIDS epidemic and the positive impact Nine Circles Community Health Centre is making.

Andrew Kushnir directs: "I hope that we can let our losses speak to one another through this play; speak, and laugh, and cry, and remember, and somehow, together, in the dark, feel that little bit lighter."

Casey and Diana stars Sharon Bajer as Marjorie, Noah Beemer as Andrew, Alicia Johnston as Pauline, Gloria Mampuya as Vera, Gregory Prest as Thomas and Catherine Wreford as Diana.

The creative team features Director Andrew Kushnir, Set & Costume Designer Joshua Quinlan, Lighting Designer Logan Raju Cracknell, Composer & Sound Designer Ashley Au, Fight Director Geoff Scovell, Dialect Coach Rebecca Cuthbertson, Assistant Director Tara Rosling, Stage Manager Michael Hart, Assistant Stage Manager Samantha Desiree, Apprentice Stage Manager Samantha Sage.
