WINNIPEG October 7, 2025 – Royal Manitoba Theatre Centre launches its 2025/26 Mainstage season with the powerful and visually stunning production of *Life of Pi*, adapted from the award-winning novel by Canadian author Yann Martel. In partnership with Citadel Theatre and directed by Haysam Kadri, this thought-provoking story comes to life on stage with stunning puppetry from Puppet Stuff Canada, Western Canada's only full-time puppet creation studio.

Life of Pi marks Haysam Kadri's first directorial engagement with Royal MTC, "Life of Pi is the kind of theatre that reminds us why we gather: it's breathtaking, surprising, and at its core, a story that moves people in a very real way," said Kadri.
