## Award-winning duo collaborate for the 7th time in 30 years to create Let's Run Away

**WINNIPEG, November 14, 2022 - Let's Run Away** is a raucous, heartbreaking and slightly unhinged performance of love and abandonment from celebrated Canadian theatre artists Daniel MacIvor and Daniel Brooks. This one-man show features a man, a memoir and a guitar to tell the story of two lives lived, even if it's not in the traditional way.

MacIvor and Brooks embarked on this project, their seventh solo show together in 30 years, in 2017. During the writing process, MacIvor, the godfather to Brooks' daughters, would talk into a microphone while Brooks listened, edited and analyzed in real time. "... the foundation of our method is deep listening," says Brooks.

MacIvor and Brooks have both won the Siminovitch Prize in Theatre.
