WINNIPEG, February 1, 2024 – In this gripping reimagination of the night before King's assassination, we witness the hope and struggle of a man who must confront his destiny and his legacy to the people.

After delivering one of his most memorable speeches, an exhausted Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. retires to his motel amidst a raging thunderstorm. When a mysterious maid arrives at his door, political discussion ensues, and Dr. King is forced to confront his legacy in a poetic reimagining of the events taking place on the night before his assassination. The Mountaintop returns to the Royal MTC stage in-person, after a digital run in 2021, and stars **Cherissa Richards** as Camae and **Ray Strachan** as Martin Luther King Jr.

In 2021, Cherissa Richards showcased her exceptional talent as both and actress and director. She portrayed the character of Camae in Royal MTC's digital production of *The Mountaintop* and was the winner of Crow's Theatre RBC Rising Star Emerging Director Prize 2021. Other Royal MTC credits include *The Mountaintop* (2021), *Sense and Sensibility, Di and Viv and Rose, A Christmas Carol, The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-Time* (with Citadel), *Mrs. Warren's Profession*.

Ray Strachan, a well-known performer in the Manitoba theatre community, is back in the role of Martin Luther King Jr. Other Royal MTC credits include *Into the Woods, The Three Musketeers, Calpurnia, The Mountaintop* (2021), *It's a Wonderful Life: The Radio Play, Shakespeare in Love* (with Citadel), *The Man Who Shot Liberty Valance, Romeo and Juliet, One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest* (with TC).

Both from Manitoba, Cherissa Richards and Ray Strachan have worked extensively on numerous projects throughout the province.
