WINNIPEG, March 2, 2023 – The kettle is on, the bannock is warm and the conversations in **The Secret to Good Tea** are difficult but necessary. Rosanna Deerchild's first play opens up a dialogue about residential schools, intergenerational trauma, and the path to healing, forgiveness and hope.

At the kitchen table, Maggie and her daughter Gwynn discuss Gwynn's shaky marriage, Maggie's lingering nightmares and a neighbour's annoyingly streak at bingo. But they talk without saying much and old family hurts simmer. When Gwynn encourages her mother to return to the site of her residential school, frustration boils over. As a journalist, Gwynn wants her mom to share her story so the world will know what happened. But how can Maggie expose her trauma to a world that turned its back on her, when she can't even talk to her own daughter?

Developed for the 2021 Pimootayowin Creators Circle under the guidance of lan Ross, Deerchild's piece has been a lifetime in the making. Following five years of listening to her mother's painful memories, Deerchild turned that pain into a book of poetry called "calling down the sky". This inspiration could not be bound by a single artistic medium and was later channelled into *The Secret to Good Tea*.

"The Secret to Good Teα honours that journey and her strength as a survivor. But it's also a larger conversation about intergenerational trauma and healing while asking the question 'who is responsible for reconciliation?'" said Deerchild.

The Secret to Good Teα stars Kathleen MacLean as Gwynn Starr, Tracey Nepinak as Maggie Mooswa, Jeremy Proulx as Mr. BigChief, James Dallas Smith as Michael, Emily Solstice Tait as Crow and Kelsey Kanatan Wavey as Nicki.
