This role leads Royal MTC's annual individual giving program, manages a portfolio of donors and prospects, oversees stewardship and donor recognition, and helps identify the next generation of major gift supporters. The Manager, Individual Giving helps foster a culture of philanthropy where every interaction strengthens a lifelong connection to Royal MTC.
