

MESSAGE FROM THE ARTISTIC DIRECTOR



Welcome to MTC's 2025/26 season. It is my pleasure to bring these two remarkable shows to the stage. One marks the return of the brilliant Ronnie Burkett to MTC after a 20-year hiatus, with his newest work *Wonderful Joe*, while our production of *Life of Pi* is the first non-replica production since the play premiered in the UK in 2019. This all-Canadian premiere is even more significant as the story, lovingly adapted for the stage by British playwright Lolita Chakrabarti, was born in the mind of celebrated Canadian author Yann Martel.

Not only are these two shows united by dazzling puppetry, but both Joe and Pi face a sort of forced

eviction, Pi's being from a shipwreck, while Joe's is quite literal as he is displaced by a condo development. Likewise, both are accompanied on their journey by significant sidekicks who happen to be animals. Granted the threatening presence of Richard Parker, the Royal Bengal Tiger who is in Pi's lifeboat is a far cry from Mister the dog, Joe's trusted companion who accompanies him on a farewell tour of his neighbourhood. But nonetheless these extraordinary portraits of human resilience and survival are surprisingly aligned as their heroes face epic challenges in their struggle for existence.

Good storytelling should both entertain and enlighten, and these productions deliver in spades. Wonderful Joe's commentary on the cost of gentrification, precarity and the power of community is a resounding call. While Life of Pi asks us to reflect on faith, trauma, perseverance and the power of story itself. I hope you enjoy these incredible plays.



SYNOPSIS - When presented with the opportunity to relocate to Canada following civil unrest in their community, Pi and his family gather the animals from their spectacular Pondicherry Zoo. Travelling aboard a cargo ship on the Pacific Ocean, tragedy strikes and a shipwreck strands Pi on a lifeboat alone - save for a small surviving menagerie of animals including a Royal Bengal tiger named Richard Parker. As the company on the lifeboat rapidly dwindles and days turn into weeks, Pi and Richard Parker learn to coexist and fight for survival. Staying alive in a vast and unforgiving ocean is no easy feat, and Pi is forced to confront the limits of faith, resilience and his own perception of the world around him.
