Elzéar Goulet was born on November 18, 1836 in St. Boniface. He was the son of Alexis Goulet and Josephte Siveright and was the third child in a family of six children. He was the mailman for the Red River Settlement.

Elzéar inherited his zeal for Métis rights from his father, Alexis. He was one of 22 other buffalo hunters and traders who assembled on August 29, 1845 to write a letter demanding Métis rights to hunt and trade at a fair price. Elzéar was named the Lieutenant General of the Métis Militia during the 1870 resistance. His older brother Roger was a member of the Council of Assiniboine and his younger brother, Maxime, became an MLA and the Minister of Agriculture. Elzéar died on September 13, 1870, at the age of 34. He left a wife and six children behind.






Sam's mom, Val Vint, raised her kids with a fierce loyal love even when she was not raised with that love. She continues to inspire us.

MIX TAPES FROM MY MOM

In 2019, Winnipeg theatre veteran Cory Wojcik wrote and performed a beautifully funny and heartbreakingly personal story of one of the 'best/worst days' of his life. The show struck a deep chord with Winnipeg Fringe audiences and especially with Royal MTC Artistic Director Kelly Thornton who was inspired to program a new version for the Regional Tour bringing Cory and original Director and Dramaturg Trish Cooper together again.

The company hit the road on February 12, bringing Mix Tapes From My Mom to 21 communities, travelling over 6,600km and warming the hearts of 2,765 patrons.

Interspersed with select tracks found on his Mom's old mix tapes, as well as a few original songs, Cory was joined onstage by musicians Christy Taronno and Josh Bellan for a show chock-full of songs you know and love, telling a story so unbelievable it could only be true.

Winter often rears its ugly head as the company is packing their bags, however this year the cast and crew including Sadie Wannamaker, Larissa Shabaga, Joshua Gehman and Jess Rose were blessed with good road conditions and safe travels throughout the 30-day tour.

This season we ran two free programs for youth in grades 10-12.

In Young Expressions, 8 students were invited to opening nights to hear from an artist or reviewer guest, see performances, and express their reactions. At their final session, the group created a zine together celebrating their experiences and favourite moments over the season. We heard from the participants that "this program helped me affirm what I want to do with my life"; they appreciated "the chance for educational and hilarious moments" and Young Expressions was "an amazing place to explore and experience theatre while you develop your critical sense in a safe positive space."

In Backstage Pass, **21 students** experienced six eye-opening workshops led by theatre professionals, then attended matinees. After each show they participated in a Talkback session with actors. Students explored set and costume design, acting, sound, props and playwriting. Here are some of their session responses:

"It is awesome that we get to speak to so many professionals in the industry."

"I loved that everyone was so open and easy to talk to."

"I discovered that I really like prop and set design and it would be something I'm interested in as a career."

"Learning how to dissect the music and talking about the process of creating was really interesting."




